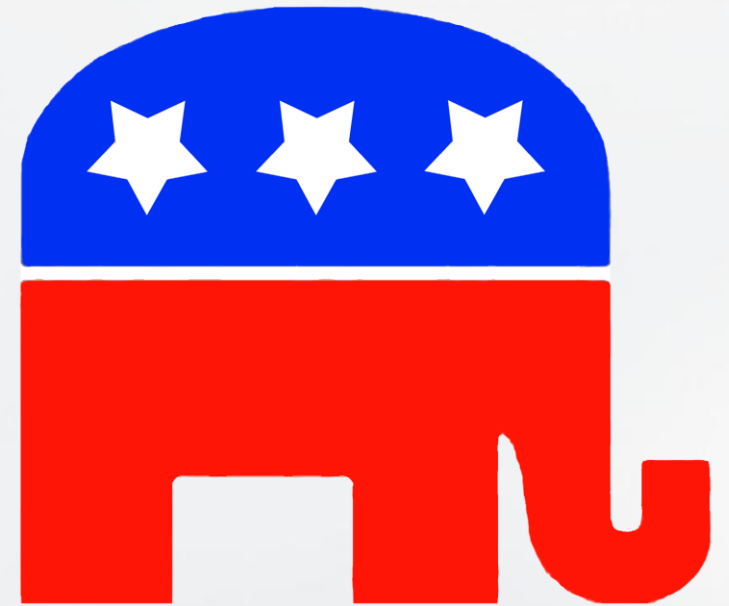

Michigan Republican Party

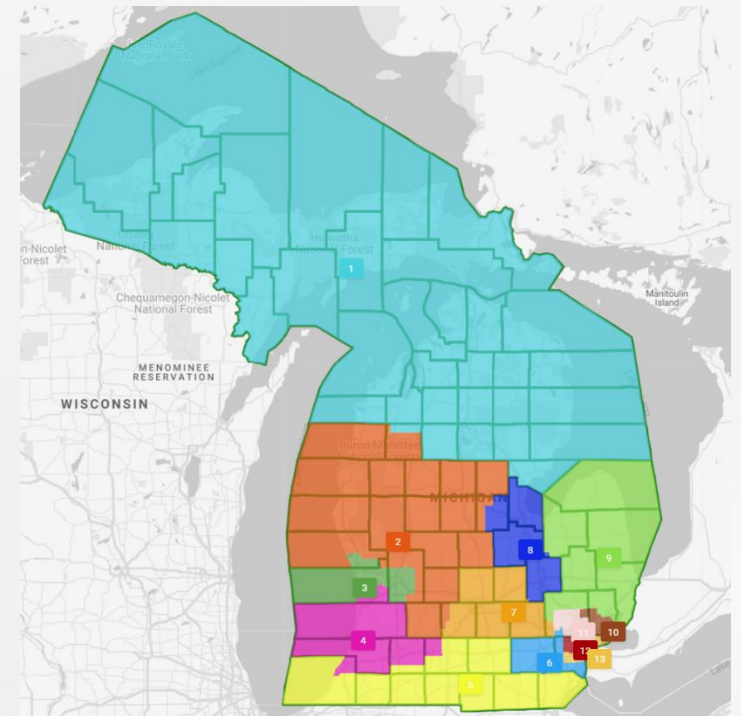
- State Central Committee (MIGOP)
- Congressional District Committees (13)
- County Executive Committees (not Wayne)
- Wayne County District Committees (12 & 6)
- Wayne County Republican Committee

State Central Committee

- Chair, Co-Chair, & 6 Vice Chairs
- Congressional District Members
 - 7 from each of the 13 districts
- National Committeeman & Committeewoman
- Secretary, Treasurer, General Counsel, Finance Chair, President of the Republican Women's Federation of MI & Chair of a County Executive Committee

Congressional District Committees

- Chair, Vice Chair, Secretary & Treasurer
- 6 Members who will serve on the State Central Committee
- 15 Additional Members
- Create their own bylaws & rules of procedures.



County Executive Committee

82 County Executive Committees

– not in Wayne because population is over 1.5 million

- **Statutory Members**- all candidates for county offices & state legislative offices who were most recently nominated in the August primary election
- **Elected Members** - a number of persons equal to the number of Statutory Members, selected by Precinct Delegates.

Wayne County Structure

- **Wayne County** – is structured differently than any other county in the State of Michigan.
- **Congressional District 13** – This district resides completely within Wayne County; Precinct Delegates only elect a Congressional District Committee at its January 26 County Convention. This includes 25 members.

Wayne County Structure continued

- **Congressional District 6 & 12** – overlap Oakland and/or Washtenaw counties. Precinct delegates from all counties within each district will elect their Congressional District Committee members at the District Caucus on the night before the State Convention February 18.
- **Wayne 6 & 12 Districts** – will meet January 26 at separate conventions to elect a Chair, Vice Chair, Secretary, Treasurer and 10 Executive Committee members. Precinct Delegates will also select Delegates to the State Convention.

Wayne County Structure continued

Wayne County Republican Committee (WCRC)

The WCRC furthers the purpose of the Republican Party in Wayne County.

WCRC membership consists of members from Congressional Districts 6, 12 & 13 in Wayne County. The committee is selected by each District Committee and must be a voting resident in the District they represent.

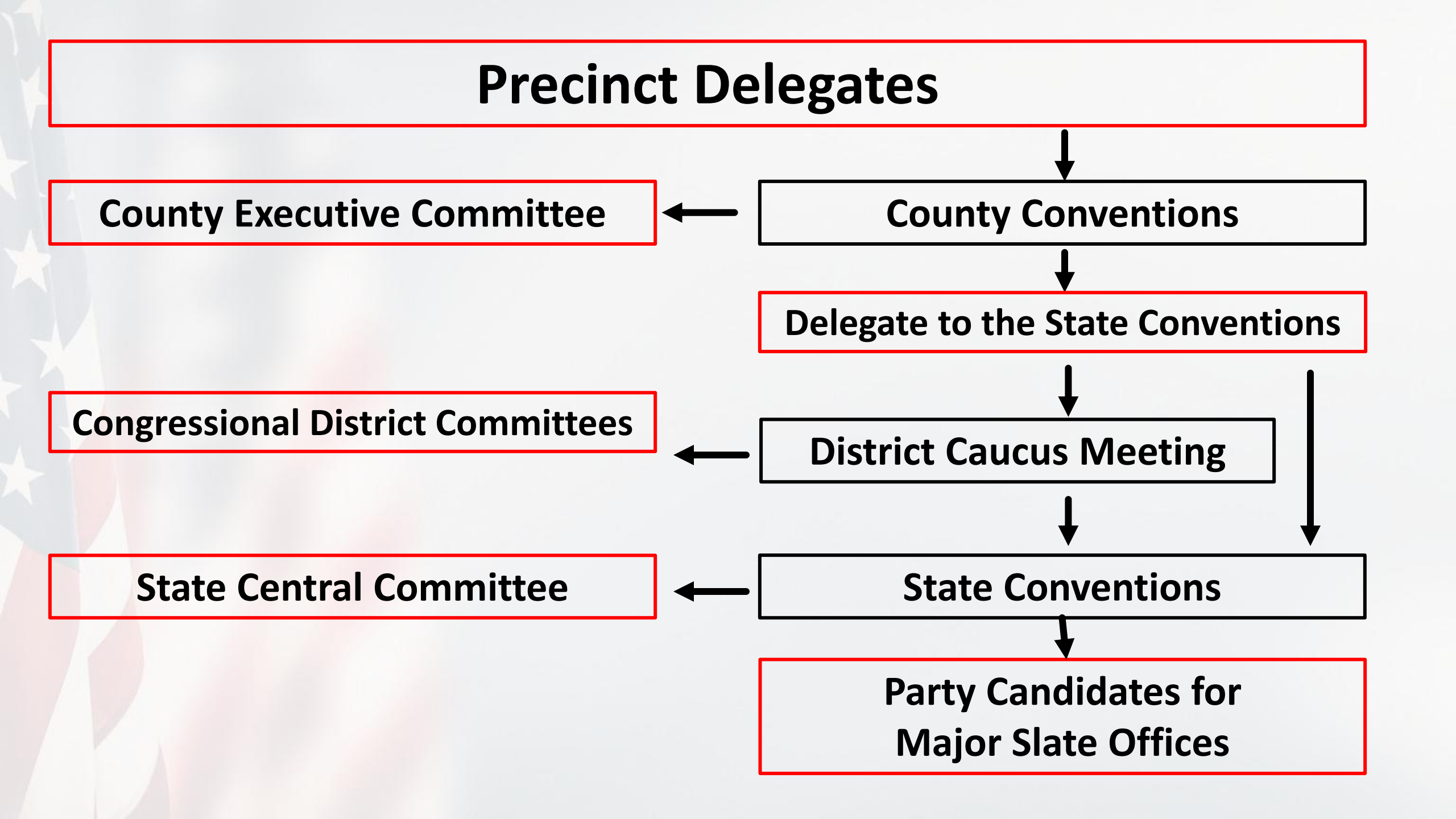
